

Today, there are thirty-four bridges. The most famous is east of the city center, near the Tower of London. Workers finished Tower Bridge in 1894. The road across the bridge goes up in the center when big ships come through. The bridge is one of the most famous places in London. ____2___

The river helped London in many ways, but it also brought problems. For years, people threw things into it. The city's toilets ran into the river, too. The river was very dirty and its water was dangerous. By the 1950s, there were no fish. Today, things are different. 3
